SUMMARY OF OPINION:

The defendant-hospital in this malpractice action filed a preliminary objection based upon Alumni Association Delta Zeta of Lambda Chi Alpha Fratemity v. Sullivan, 369 Pa. Super. 596, 535 A.2d 1095 (1987), and argued that plaintiff alleged negligent care at the hospital's Scranton and Wilkes-Barre campuses, but neglected to identify by name and with specificity which alleged agents of the hospital were negligent. In Alumni Association, the Superior Court originally indicated that in pleading a vicarious liability claim, a plaintiff must identify the agent by name or appropriate description, and set forth the agent's authority and how the tortious acts of the agent either fell within the scope of that authority or were ratified by the principal. However, in Sokolsky v. Eidelman, 93 A.3d 858 (Pa. Super. 2014), the Superior Court later concluded that "simply because employees are unnamed within a complaint or referred to as a unit, i.e., the staff, does not preclude one's claim against their employer under vicarious liability if the employees acted nealigently during the course and within the scope of their employment." Id. at 866. It subsequently reaffirmed that "filn Sokolsky we concluded that it is not necessary for a plaintiff to establish a right to recover on a claim for vicarious liability based upon the negligence of a specific named employee." Estate of Denmark ex rel. Hurst v. Williams, 117 A.3d 300, 306 Pa. Super, 2015). More recently, the Superior Court reversed the holding of a visiting senior judge in this county who erroneously held that a plaintiff asserting a vicarious liability claim must identify the alleged agent(s) by name. See Breslin v. Mountain View Nursing Home, Inc., 171 A.3d 818, 828-829 (Pa. Super. 2017) (relying upon Sokolsky and Estate of Denmark). Therefore, the hospital's preliminary objection was overruled, and the hospital was directed to seek the requested information by way of pre-trial discovery rather than as supporting evidence in the complaint.

SUMMARY OF OPINION:

A Dauphin County resident, who was involved in an auto accident in Schuylkill County, filed a personal injury action against ten defendants, including the state department of transportation and its employee, and those Commonwealth parties filed preliminary objections asserting *inter alia*, improper venue. Based upon 42 Pa.C.S. § 8523(a) and 37 Pa. Code § 111.4(c), the state agency and its employee could be sued only in the county where (a) the cause of action arose, (b) the agency maintains its principal office, or (c) the Commonwealth party's local office is located for the county where the cause of action arose, even in those instances where the plaintiff asserts joint and several liability against multiple defendants. Since venue could not be laid in Lackawanna County under those statutory and regulatory provisions, the preliminary objection asserting improper venue was sustained and, pursuant to Pa.R.C.P. 1006(e), the action was transferred to the Court of Common Pleas of Schuylkill County to address the remaining objections.
