

WHY: First responders selflessly devote their lives to serving our communities. Event Information

We need 10 to 20 lawyers, at least 4 notaries, and 8 witnesses (who do not have to be lawyers) for the event. Lawyer Volunteers do not need to practice trust and estate law. We will conduct a one-hour refresher course the morning of the event to familiarize Lawyer Volunteers with what they need to know. Anthony Hayes, a South Carolina lawyer, who wanted to do something meaningful to help the country after the September 11, 2001 terrorist attacks, founded the Wills for Heroes program. He met with South Carolina fire fighters and noted a glaring need for estate planning services.

Each first responder sits with a Lawyer Volunteer to review a questionnaire that the first responder has filled out in advance. The Lawyer Volunteer enters the information into a computer-based program and reviews the documents with the first responder to ensure accuracy. The documents are printed, signed, and notarized.
