PIKE COUNTY DISTRICT ATTORNEY PRESS RELEASE PIKE COUNTY SENTENCING INFORMATION

September 3, 2020 — Pike County District Attorney Raymond J. Tonkin announced the following criminal sentences were issued by Pike County Court of Common Pleas President Judge Gregory Chelak:

Douglas Kristiansen, age 66, of Greeley, PA, was sentenced to 26 days to 12 months in the Pike County Jail and fined \$600.00 for the crimes of Simple Assault and Resisting Arrest. The state police responded to a residence in Blooming Grove Township on September 17, 2019, where Kristiansen was involved in a domestic dispute during which he struck an individual. When the state police attempted to place Kristiansen under arrest, they had to use additional force due to his resistance.

Daniel Joseph Skibber, age 24, of Paupack, PA, was sentenced to 6 months of the Pike Care Probation which will include 30 days of electronic monitoring, a fine of \$750.00 and a driver's license suspension of 12 months for the crime of Driving Under the Influence. Skibber was stopped by the state police on March 19, 2020, for speeding along SR 390 in Palmyra Township. The trooper detected the smell of an alcoholic beverage and observed Skibber to have bloodshot, glassy eyes. Field Sobriety Tests showed impairment and a breath test confirmed a blood alcohol content of .116%.

Teaira Michell Hartley, age 22, of McKeesport, PA, was sentenced to 5 years of the Pike Care Program which will include 90 days on electronic monitoring, a fine of \$1,500.00 and driver's license suspension of 18 months for the crime of Driving Under the Influence. Hartley was stopped by the state police on November 10, 2019, for traveling slow and drifting along her lane of travel of I-84 in Blooming Grove Township. Hartley admitted to smoking Marihuana prior to driving. Field Sobriety Tests showed impairment and a blood test confirmed the presence of THC in her blood.

Denise Rose Millspaugh, age 31, of Port Jervis, NY, was sentenced to 18 months of probation and a fine of \$600.00 for 2 counts of the crime of Possession of a Controlled Substance. The state police responded to Twin Lakes Road in Shohola Township on August 30, 2019, for a report of a suspicious person. Millspaugh was found in possession of Crack Cocaine and Heroin.

Gerard Louis Mignosi, age 42, of East Stroudsburg, PA, was sentenced to 1 year to 5 years in the Pike County Jail, fined \$2,900.00 and had his driver's license suspended for 18 months for the crime of Driving Under the Influence and the Summary Offenses of Required Financial Responsibility, Restraint Systems and Operation of Vehicle Without Certificate of Inspection. The state police responded to Winona Falls Road in Lehman Township on September 29, 2019, where Mignosi had crashed his vehicle. Present in the vehicle with Mignosi was a minor child who was not wearing a seat belt. Mignosi admitted to ingesting Suboxone, Seroquel and Ambien

the previous night. Mignosi performed the Field Sobriety Tests which showed impairment and was observed to have pinpoint pupils. Mignosi refused to submit to a blood test. Mignosi was also found displaying a fraudulent Pennsylvania inspection sticker in his vehicle and had no insurance.

Chase Vincent Kennedy, age 20, of Tafton, PA, was sentenced to 72 hours to 12 months in the Pike County Jail, fined \$1,300.00 and had his driver's license suspended for 12 months for the crimes of Driving Under the Influence of a Controlled or Counterfeit Substance and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. The state police observed Kennedy turn off SR 507 onto Soose Way in Palmyra Township and drive off the road into a ditch on May 21, 2019. Upon speaking with Kennedy, the trooper detected the smell of Marihuana and observed Kennedy's eyes to be bloodshot and glassy with dilated pupils. Field Sobriety Tests showed impairment. Kennedy admitted to smoking Marihuana prior to police contact. A probable cause search revealed a baggie, grinder, pipe and pill bottle.

Jennifer Lynn Keegan, age 37, of Olyphant, PA, was sentenced to 3 months to 12 months in the Pike County Jail and a fine of \$300.00 for the crime of Theft by Unlawful Taking or Disposition. Keegan took a checkbook belonging to an individual residing in Greene Township between June 25, 2018 and June 28, 2018, and cashed a check in the amount of \$400.00 without the account owner's permission.

James Dupree Bryan, age 22, of Greentown, PA, was sentenced to a fine of \$300.00 for the crime of Possession of a Small Amount of Marihuana. On April 1, 2019, a state trooper on patrol along SR 507 in Greene Township observed Bryan and his passenger hunched over in his vehicle in a business parking lot. Upon making contact with the occupants, the trooper detected the smell of Marihuana. Bryan was found in possession of Marihuana.

Brian McKnight, age 28, of Milford, PA, was sentenced to a fine of \$300.00 for the Summary Offense of Disorderly Conduct. On December 31, 2019, deputies arrived at a residence in Dingman Township with three active warrants for McKnight. McKnight caused a public disruption.

Nigel Austin Tuten, age 28, of Tamiment, PA, was sentenced to 1 year of probation and a fine of \$200.00 for the crime of Simple Assault. On December 6, 2019, Tuten was involved in a domestic dispute where he struck an individual in the face with a closed fist causing injury.


