

AND NOW, This 24<sup>th</sup> day of January. 2012, the following conditions in addition to the general condition of probation and parole of York County Adult Probation and Parole Department, are hereby imposed on all Defendants who are being supervised for any of the following offense; (and any other offenses not listed below which may be sexual in nature):

Endangering Welfare of Child (offense of sexual nature)

Cruelty to Animals (offense of sexual nature) Patronizing Prostitution

Criminal Trespass (offense of sexual nature) Failure to Register

The conditions of supervision for sexual offenders, in addition to the general conditions of Probation and Parole, shall be as follows:

- 1 Defendant shall be required to obtain a sex offender evaluation by an agency designated by the York County Adult Probation Department and follow through with all recommendation as per such evaluation including successful completion of the sex offender program. Defendant shall assume all responsibility for the costs of any required program.

- 7. If Defendant's current offense involved a minor child, there will be no unauthorized contact with minors. Any contact with minors must be pre-approved by the Probation and Parole Department.
