

Mortgage Foreclosure - Preliminary Objections

- Defendants filed Preliminary Objections to the Complaint in Mortgage Foreclosure claiming that Plaintiff failed to comply with Pa.R. Civ.P. 1019(h) and (i) because it did not attach a copy of the Adjustable Rate Note and because Plaintiff did not state a reason for not attaching the same.
- Defendants claimed that Plaintiff's Complaint is in violation of Pa.R. Civ.P. 1028(a)(2) for failure to conform to the Pennsylvania Rules of Civil Procedure and should be dismissed.
- 3. The Court held that in its Complaint in Mortgage Foreclosure, Plaintiff satisfied the requirements of Pennsylvania Rule of Civil Procedure 1147(a) in their entirety. Plaintiff was not required to attach a copy of the Note or state a reason for not attaching the same. Plaintiff sufficiently complied with the rules of civil actions, specifically Pa.R.Civ.P. 1019(h) and (i). Therefore, its Complaint conformed with Pennsylvania Rule of Civil Procedure 1028(a)(2) and will not be dismissed.
- The Court OVERRULED Defendants' Preliminary Objections to the Complaint.

OPINION

Before this Court for disposition are the Preliminary Objections, filed by Melinda Sue Hughes and Adam Hughes (hereinafter, "Defendants"), to OneWest Bank N.A's (hereinafter, "Plaintiff") Complaint in Mortgage Foreclosure seeking to foreclose its mortgage against the real property located at 3701 Jefferson Road, Glen Rock, PA 17327. Defendants claim that Plaintiff failed to comply with Pa.R.Civ.P. 1019(h) and (i) because it did not attach a copy of the Adjustable Rate Note and because Plaintiff did not state a reason for not attaching the same. Defendants claim that Plaintiff's Complaint is in violation of Pa.R.Civ.P. 1028(a)(2) for failure to conform to the Pennsylvania Rules of Civil Procedure and should be dismissed. Defendants' Preliminary Objections are OVERRULED.

FACTUAL AND PROCEDURAL HISTORY

Plaintiff filed a Civil Action Complaint in Mortgage Foreclosure on April 23, 2015, seeking a judgment against Defendants. In its complaint, Plaintiff alleged that Defendants are the Known and Unknown Surviving Heirs of Robert H. Rife, Deceased Mortgagor and Real Owner.

On January 3, 2007, Robert H. Rife made, executed, and delivered a Home Equity Conversion Mortgage to Financial Freedom Senior Funding Corporation, a subsidiary of Indymac Bank, F.S.B., upon the premises of 3701 Jefferson Road, Glen Rock, PA 17327 (hereinafter, "the property"). This mortgage is recoded in the Office of the Recorder of York County in Mortgage Book 1867, Page 6709. On January 3, 2007, Robert H. Rife also executed an Adjustable Rate Note (hereinafter, "Note") secured by the mortgage. Plaintiff is in possession of the Note and holds the Note with

the right to enforce it.

On September 25, 2009, Financial Freedom Senior Funding Corporation assigned the mortgage to Mortgage Electronic Registration Systems, Inc., its successors or assigns, as nominee for Financial Freedom Acquisition LLC. The Assignment of Mortgage is recorded in the Office of the Recorder of York County in Mortgage Book 2048, Page 4549.

On August 6, 2014, Mortgage Electronic Registration Systems, Inc., its successors or assigns, as nominee for Financial Freedom Acquisition LLC assigned the mortgage to Plaintiff. This Assignment of Mortgage is recorded in the Office of the Recorder of York County in Mortgage Book 2295, Page 2278.

On July 7, 2014, Robert H. Rife died. By terms of the mortgage, all sums due and owing thereunder are now due and payable by reason of death. The total amount due is \$141, 453.26. This amount is the sum of the Principal Balance (\$104,887.69), Interest through April 30, 2015, plus monthly interest thereafter which may adjust in accordance with the terms of the Note and mortgage (\$25,135.79), Mortgage Insurance Premiums (\$8,429.78), and the Monthly Servicing Fees (\$3,000.00).

On July 8, 2015, Defendants filed Preliminary Objections requesting that the Court dismiss Plaintiff's Complaint for failure to conform with Pennsylvania Rule of Civil Procedure 1028(a)(2). Plaintiff filed an Answer to and a Memorandum of Law in Opposition to Defendants' Preliminary Objections on July 17, 2015. Defendants filed a Brief in Support on July 20, 2015. On August 3, 2015, Plaintiff filed a Praecipe to List for One-Judge Disposition in order to consider and dispose of Defendants' Preliminary Objections without oral argument. This matter was assigned to the undersigned on September 3, 2015.

DISCUSSION

Preliminary objections should be granted in cases that are "clear and free from doubt." *Pennsylvania AFL-CIO ex rel. George v. Commonwealth*, 563 Pa. 108, 114, 757 A.2d 917, 920 (2000) (citing *Bower v. Bower*, 531 Pa. 54, 57, 611 A.2d 181, 182 (1992)). The court must generally accept as true all well and clearly pled facts, together with such reasonable inferences as may be drawn from those facts, but not the pleader's conclusions or averments of law. *Santiago v. Pennsylvania National Mutual Casualty Insurance Company*, 418 Pa. Super. 178, 184-85, 613 A.2d 1235, 1238-39 (1992).

A proper ground for a preliminary objection is a pleading's failure to conform to law. See Pa.R.Civ.P. 1028(a)(2). The law governing pleadings requires "[w]hen any claim or defense is based upon an agreement, the pleading shall state specifically if the agreement is oral or written." Pa.R. Civ.P. 1019(h). "If the agreement is in writing, it must be attached to the pleading." Id. Furthermore, "[w]hen any claim or defense is based upon a writing, the pleader shall attach a copy of the writing, or the material part thereof, but if the writing or copy is not accessible to the pleader, it is sufficient so to state, together with the reason, and to set forth the substance in writing." Pa.R.Civ.P. 1019(i).

An action of mortgage foreclosure is governed by additional, mortgage action-specific, rules. Pennsylvania Rule of Civil Procedure 1141 controls the interaction between the rules of general civil actions and the rules of mortgage foreclosures. It states, "Je]xcept as otherwise provided in this chapter, the procedure in the action [of mortgage foreclosure] shall be in accordance with the rules relating to a civil action." Pa.R.Civ.P. 1141 (emphasis added). Read plainly, it directs that rules governing general civil actions must yield to rules specific to actions of mortgage foreclosure.

In a mortgage foreclosure action, the pleader must set forth six items in its complaint: (1) the parties to and the date of the mortgage, and of any assignments, and a statement of the place of record of the mortgage and assignments; (2) a description of the land subject to the mortgage; (3) the names, addresses and interest of the defendants in the action and that the present real owner is unknown if the real owner is not made a party; (4) a specific averment of default; (5) an itemized statement of the amount due; and (6) a demand for judgment for the amount due. Pa.R.Civ.P. 1147(a). Accordingly, if a mortgage foreclosure action contains all six items, it shall be deemed compliant with Pennsylvania Rules of Civil Procedure 1019(h), (i), and 1028(a)(2). Notably absent from this list is a requirement that the pleader attach the property's promissory note to the complaint.

The Pennsylvania Superior Court addressed this exact issue in *Bank of New York Mellon v. Johnson*. In *Johnson*, the Appellee did not attach the promissory note to its mortgage foreclosure action. *Bank of New York Mellon v. Johnson*, --- A.3d ----, 2015 PA Super 174 (Aug. 19, 2015). The Appellant moved for default judgment, arguing that a mortgage foreclosure complaint must include the promissory note. *Id.* The Appellant argued that a failure to attach the promissory note rendered the complaint

deficient. *Id.* The Superior Court disagreed. *Id.* It concurred with the trial court's finding that "a complaint in a mortgage foreclosure does not need to include the original promissory note." *Id.* It concluded that the Appellee's complaint was sufficient because it contained all of the information required by Rule 1147(a). *Id.*

In the present case, Plaintiff: (1) identified the Defendant as Melinda Sue Hughes and Unknown Surviving Heirs of Robert H. Rife, Deceased Mortgagor and Real Owner and explained the protracted chain of mortgage assignments and recordings, including the places of record of mortgage, as outlined in detail above; (2) included a description of the land at issue within the attached Exhibit "A"; (3) set forth the names and address of Defendants, which address is the same address as the property at issue; (4) stated that, per the terms of the mortgage, all sums due and owing are now due and payable by reason of the death of Robert H. Rife, Deceased Mortgagor and Real Owner; (5) included an itemized statement of the amounts due; and (6) demanded *in rem* judgment in the sum of \$141,453.26.

In its Complaint in Mortgage Foreclosure, Plaintiff satisfied the requirements of Pennsylvania Rule of Civil Procedure 1147(a) in their entirety. Plaintiff was not required to attach a copy of the Note or state a reason for not attaching the same. Plaintiff sufficiently complied with the rules of civil actions, specifically Pa.R.Civ.P. 1019(h) and (i). Therefore, its Complaint conformed with Pennsylvania Rule of Civil Procedure 1028(a)(2) and will not be dismissed.

CONCLUSION

Having reviewed the record in the context of Defendants' Preliminary Objections, the Court will overrule them as set forth in this Opinion. The Defendants are ordered to file an Answer to Plaintiff's Complaint in Mortgage Foreclosure within twenty (20) days. An order consistent with this Opinion will be entered.
