Petition for counsel to withdraw appearance

- Pennsylvania Rule of Professional Conduct 1.16(b)(4) provides a lawyer may withdraw from representing a client if the client insists upon taking action that the lawyer considers repugnant or with which the lawyer has a fundamental disagreement.
- Pennsylvania Rule of Professional Conduct 1.16(b)(5) provides a lawyer may
 withdraw from representing a client if the client fails substantially to fulfill an
 obligation to the lawyer regarding the lawyer's services and has been given
 reasonable warning that the lawyer will withdraw unless the obligation is
 fulfilled.
- 3. The parties' settlement agreement was recited on the record with the intent that it would be formalized in a separate written document. The parties failed to formalize their settlement agreement. Petitioners, attorneys for two Defendants, aver that a fundamental disagreement exists between Petitioners and Defendants; Defendants refuse to pay Petitioners; and Petitioners have given notice of their intent to withdraw. Defendants do not deny that a fundamental disagreement exists or that they refuse to pay Petitioners. Instead, Defendants oppose Petitioners' request on the ground that Petitioners may yet be of use to Defendants in resolving their dispute with Plaintiffs; the parties appear close to a final resolution; it is not a good time for counsel to be removed from the case and retaining new counsel will be prohibitively expensive to bring them up to speed. Because Petitioners present a *prima facie* claim and Defendants fail to present meritorious opposition, the Petition of Counsel for two of the Defendants for Leave to Withdraw Appearances was granted.

AND NOW, this 31st day of March, upon consideration of the Petition of Counsel for Defendants My Nga Tran-Ferraro and John D. Ferraro for Leave to Withdraw Appearances filed March 8, 2023, and the Response filed thereto, it is hereby **ORDERED** that the Petition is **GRANTED** and that Petitioners may withdraw their appearances forthwith.

MEMORANDUM

On January 9, 2023, in lieu of trial, the parties' settlement agreement was recited on the record with the intent that it would be formalized in a separate written document. The parties failed to formalize their settlement agreement and Plaintiffs filed a Motion to Enforce Settlement Agreement² on February 10, 2023 which the court will decide in due course.

Presently before the court is the Petition of Counsel for Defendants My Nga Tran-Ferraro and John D. Ferraro for Leave to Withdraw Appearances filed March 8, 2023. Petitioners aver that a fundamental disagreement exists between Petitioners and Defendants. Petition, 3/8/2023, ¶ 7. Petitioners also aver that Defendants refuse to pay Petitioners and that Petitioners have given notice of their intent to withdraw. Petition, 3/8/2023, ¶¶ 9-10, 12, 15. Petitioners ground their request for leave to withdraw on Pennsylvania Rule of Professional Conduct 1.16(b)(4) ("a lawyer…may withdraw from representing a client if the client insists upon taking action that the lawyer considers repugnant or with which the lawyer has a fundamental disagreement."). Petitioners also ground their request for leave to withdraw on Pennsylvania Rule of Professional Conduct 1.16(b)(5) (""a lawyer…may withdraw from representing a client if the client fails substantially to fulfill an obligation to the lawyer regarding the lawyer's services and has been given reasonable warning that the lawyer will withdraw unless the obligation is fulfilled.").

Defendants filed their Response on March 13, 2023. Defendants do not deny that a fundamental disagreement exists or that they refuse to pay Petitioners. *See* Response, 3/13/2023, ¶¶ 1- 10. Instead, Defendants oppose Petitioners' request on the ground that Petitioners may yet be of use to Defendants in resolving their dispute with Plaintiffs. Response, 3/13/2023, ¶2 (alleging that the parties "appea[r] to be close to final resolution" and that "now is not a good time for our representatives to be removed from the case."). Defendants also oppose Petitioners' request on the ground that retaining new counsel will be prohibitively expensive. Response, 3/13/2023, ¶3 ("It would also be a significant financial burden for us to bring a new legal representative in and bring them up to speed."). Defendants thus ask this court to compel Petitioners to continue to represent Defendants without payment despite the fundamental disagreement that exists between them. Response, 3/13/2023, ¶5 ("We believe that removal of Petitioner Lawyers should only occur after a final agreement is in force.").

Here, Petitioners present a *prima facie* claim while Defendants fail to present a meritorious opposition. Defendants ask this court to force Petitioners to continue working for them without payment while suggesting that this imposition will not last long since "the matter is close to final resolution." Response,

3/13/2023, ¶ 10. However, the anticipated duration of the imposition is irrelevant when the issue is whether Defendants should be allowed to continue to impose on Petitioners at all. Moreover, even if Defendants had averred that they intend to pay Petitioners, eventually, Defendants have failed to deny Petitioners' averment that there exists a fundamental disagreement between them, which is an independent ground sufficient to warrant the relief sought by Petitioners.

Accordingly, this court will enter an order that grants the Petition of Counsel for Defendants My Nga Tran-Ferraro and John D. Ferraro for Leave to Withdraw Appearances filed March 8, 2023.


