

Recollections From My Early Legal Career Harry L. McNeal, Jr.

Judge Adams' letter of several weeks ago concerning the then forthcoming trip to D.C., for admission to the Supreme Court of the United States brought to mind two experiences of many years ago. Though of no great consequence, each made a sufficient impression on me to, in my mind, be worthy of archiving. With more free time than before, I decided to do so.

I'll take the later first.

Like numerous law school classmates I was hired by a Wall Street area law firm. My firm was Mitchell, Capron Marsh, Angulo & Cooney. Among it's numerous substantial clients was City Bank Farmers Trust(Company (the trust department of what is now CitiGroup), many foreigners including the Astor family (Lord Astor came to the office) and Felguncio Batista (the dictator of Cuba, later ousted by Castro). The senior partner was William Dewitt Mitchell, who had been Solicitor General of the United States under President Coolidge and Attorney General under Hoover. Of the widest public interest among the important matters in which he had been involved was as General Counsel to the Joint Confessional Pearl Harbor Investigating Committee. And, from the time of it's inception, he had been chairman of the committee appointed by the Supreme Court to promulgate and monitor the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure

In any event, I was assigned to work with Mr. Mitchell in one aspect of the appeal to the Supreme Court from a District Court's approval of the Interstate Commerce Commission's plan of reorganization for the Florida East Coast Railroad, which he prosecuted on behalf of St. Joe Paper Company. St. Joe was the sole owner of the only issue of securities having any equity left the Florida East Coast. It objected to the ICC's proposal under which it would be merged into the Atlantic Coast Line. The issue was: did the ICC have the power to force a merger of a debtor railroad into another over the debtor's objection? Mr. Mitchell assigned me the task of searching the Congressional Record for evidence of legislative intent on this subject. Fortunately, indications of an intention to withhold the power which the ICC had purported to exercise appeared in the Record. After plowing through many pages of detritus I found them.



When it came time to file the brief, Mr. Mitchell inquired of the partner for whom I normally worked: "what is the name of that young man who helped us?" He was going to add my name, along with two partners, as co-counsel. Unfortunately, this was a few months before ny admission to the New York bar and he was unable to follow through with this very nice gesture. However I was able to attend argument and witnessed an unusual occurrence.

Chief Justice Warren was very early in his tenure. Back then the Court began hearing arguments at noon and continued till 2:00 p.m., at which time, sharp, they took a 30 minute break, no matter where a lawyer was in his (very few female lawyers at that time) argument. This had the potential to disrupt the chain of thought. Parenthetically, lawyers making argument wore swallow-tail coats. To sit in the counsel area, three piece suits were required - not having one, I was advised to keep all three coat buttons engaged. The case immediately preceding ours ended at about seven minutes before two o'clock. When Mr. Mitchell approached the podium, Justice Black, the senior Justice, leaned over and whispered something in Warren's right ear. Probably recognizing that, as a Californian he was not familiar with the eastern legal establishment, Black likely was telling Warren who this lawyer was and where he fit in. With that, the CJ looked up and said: "Mr. Mitchell, if it is satisfactory to you, we'll begin your argument after the break." John W. Davis, the democrat candidate for president who ran against Coolidge and who probably was the the 'dean' of the Supreme Court bar, was in the court room. After adjournment he told the partner I was with that he had never seen the Court offer such respect to counsel.

Happily and much to our client's relief, the Court reversed the ICC, relying in part on the legislative intent recorded in the Congressional Record. St. Joe Paper Co v. Atlantic Coast linw Railroad Co., 347 U.S. 298 (1954)

The second experience was during my last year in law school.

A classmate & close friend who lived in Fairfax County & I drove up from Charlottesville to his home with the intention of going to the Court the next morning to hear argument on the Texas Law School case. This was one of the early school desegregation cases - I don't recall whether it preceded or followed Brown v Board of Education & have not take the time to look. On the way up I speculated as to whether we would actually be able to get in. Hank replied: "Charlie (Picket, his



step-father, a lawyer who practiced in Fairfax County & a descendant of Major General George Picket) will call Bob Jackson." Without thought I took this to be an indication that Charlie was a friend of the Clerk. But Hank, out of character for his usual formal and respectful Virginia persona, was referring to Justice Jackson.

Charlie did call 'Bob', who spent fifteen or twenty minutes with us in chambers, had an aid show us through the Courts facilities and sat us up front in the area reserved for guests of the Justices. I have no recollection of my impressions of this experience, except of the graciousness Mr. Justice Jackson displayed to two young law students.

That weekend was topped off by Hank and I taking dates to see and hear the wonderful Nat King Cole at a DC night spot. Hank's date was the daughter of Bolitha Laws, who was Chief Judge of the DC Circuit. And my date was a recent Wellesley alumna, who, along with three classmates, would drive from Boston to Charlottesville once in the fall and once in the spring to see me and three classmates and who was then working in D.C.

I have never been admitted to the Supreme Court bar. My only petition for cert was, as an assistant public defender 40+ years ago. This was shortly after the Court had determined that a guilty plea, the waiver of the right to a jury trial, is a 'critical stage' in a criminal prosecution, entitling the accused to a lawyer. Back then indictment by a grand jury was the initial formal step in a prosecution. So, when a guilty plea was entered early in the proceedings, the waiver of a jury trial was accompanied by a waiver of grand jury indictment. My petition sought to have a waiver of indictment also be considered a critical stage and, accordingly vacated for lack of counsel. The Supreme Court refused to hear the appeal, in my judgement correctly. It is no longer clear to me what I thought success would have accomplished. Couldn't the Commonwealth simply have proceeded with indictment? But the charge was prison breach and the defendant had been on the loose for quite a long time. Perhaps I had some notion that the statute of limitations had run, so that this would then be too late.

I suppose I am fortunate to have some pleasant memories and, at 89, the ability to recall.
