Cordaro, J.

SUMMARY

Currently before this Court is the Defendant's Omnibus Pretrial Motion of habeas corpus. The Defendant is charged with DUI under 75 Pa.C.S.A § 3802(A)(1) and Careless Driving under 75 Pa.C.S.A § 3714(A). Defendant's Motion argues that there was insufficient evidence to show the Defendant was in "actual physical control" of the vehicle and therefore the Commonwealth failed to establish an essential element of the charge under § 3802(A)(1).

BACKGROUND

At the February 2, 2022 hearing on the Motion, both parties agreed to forgo testimony and consented to admission of the MVR and preliminary hearing testimony as the bases for a decision on the Motion.

On March 27, 2021, around 4:25 P.M., Pennsylvania State Trooper and affiant, Samuel Jenesky was dispatched to the area of Creek Road and Thornton Road in Fayette County on a call of a male slumped over the wheel of a vehicle. The MVR footage begins once Trooper Jenesky was already on the scene, parked behind the Defendant's vehicle which was in a gravel lot.

At the preliminary hearing, Trooper Jenesky testified that when he arrived, the Defendant was the sole occupant of the vehicle. The vehicle was not running at the time, and the Defendant was in the driver's seat, with the keys in the ignition. The trooper detected the odor of alcohol from the Defendant, and observed he had bloodshot eyes and appeared dazed. On asking the Defendant to exit the vehicle, the Defendant had to steady himself with a hand on his vehicle (according to the MVR footage, the Defendant blamed his bad leg for his lack of balance). When the trooper asked the Defendant if he had anything to drink that day, the Defendant said he had a few beers around 8:00 A.M. that morning. Trooper Jenesky performed the horizontal gaze nystagmus (HGN)

sobriety test on the Defendant, and his assessment was that the Defendant was too impaired to drive. The trooper asked the Defendant to consent to a blood test, which the Defendant refused.

There were no witnesses that observed the Defendant driving the vehicle or saw when he arrived at the gravel lot.

DISCUSSION

Under 75 Pa.C.S.A. § 3802(a)(1), "[a]n individual may not drive, operate or be in actual physical control of the movement of a vehicle after imbibing a sufficient amount of alcohol such that the individual is rendered incapable of safely driving, operating or being in actual physical control of the movement of the vehicle."

The determination of "actual physical control" involves an analysis of "a combination of the motor running, the location of the vehicle, and additional evidence showing that the defendant had driven the vehicle. In a majority of cases, the suspect location of the vehicle, which supports an inference that it was driven, is a key factor in a finding of actual control." Com. v. Byers, 650 A.2d 468, 469 (Pa. Super. Ct. 1994), abrogated by Com. v. Walen, 685 A.2d 1384 (Pa. 1996).

With respect to what constitutes 'actual physical control' in this this Commonwealth, the courts have held that whether a person is in actual physical control of a motor vehicle is determined based on the totality of circumstances, including the location of the vehicle, whether the engine was running and whether there was other evidence indicating that the defendant had driven the vehicle at some point prior to the arrival of police on the scene.

Com. v. Walen, 685 A.2d 1384, 1385 (Pa. 1996).

"'The term 'operate' requires evidence of actual physical control of either the machinery of the motor vehicle or the management of the vehicle's movement, but not evidence that the vehicle was in motion."' Com. v. Toland, 995 A.2d 1242, 1246 (Pa. Super. Ct. 2010), quoting Com. v. Johnson, 833 A.2d 260,263 (Pa. Super. Ct. 2003). Furthermore, "'[t]he Commonwealth can establish through wholly circumstantial evidence that a defendant was driving, operating or in actual physical control of a motor vehicle." Id. Although important to the analysis, whether or not the vehicle engine is running is not necessarily dispositive in itself as to whether actual physical control existed. See Com. v. Leib, 588 A.2d 922 (Pa. Super. Ct. 1991) (finding sufficient evidence of control when the vehicle engine was off, his keys were in the ignition, the defendant was asleep in the car in the middle of the road, and there were open beer containers in the vehicle); Com. v. Trial, 652 A.2d 338 (Pa. Super. Ct. 1994) (finding sufficient evidence of control when the vehicle engine was off, the defendant was in the car with his seatbelt on, the keys were in the ignition at the "on" position," and the vehicle was diagonally across a roadway).

Here, Trooper Jenesky testified that keys were in the ignition of Defendant's vehicle, but that the engine was not running. There is no factual information as to whether the engine was still warm. The Defendant's vehicle was not in the main road, but prior

case law has held that a parking lot used by the public is a "trafficway" for purposes of prosecuting DUI offenses {1} See Com. v. Proctor, 625 A.2d 1221 (Pa. Super. Ct. 1993); Com. v. Wilson, 553 A.2d 452 (Pa. Super. Ct. 1989). The MVR footage shows the Defendant's vehicle in close proximity to the main road, and that there is open access from that road into the gravel lot. The footage also shows several other vehicles in addition to the EMS vehicles are parked near the Defendant's vehicle, demonstrating that the public has access to the lot.

In the totality of circumstances in this case, the engine of the Defendant's vehicle was not running, but yet his keys were in the vehicle's ignition. This means he had control over the machinery of the vehicle; control which he would have lacked if the keys had been anywhere else. The Defendant was the only one in the vehicle, and he was in the driver's seat. His vehicle was in a lot readily accessible to the driving public, just off a main road. There is sufficient evidence to support that the Defendant did have "actual physical control" of the vehicle.

CONCLUSION

As the Commonwealth established at least a prima facie case for the elements under § 3802(A)(1), the Motion is DENIED.
