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Wagstaff, LLC v. Prudential Insurance Co.

Transfer of structured payment rights – Best interests of payee

- 1. There is no due process violation in denying a petition on its face, pursuant to the Structured Settlement Protection Act, for failure to allege facts sufficient to support a finding of a transfer being in the payee's best interests.
- 2. The Pennsylvania Structured Settlement Protection Act exists to ensure an injured individual will not be taken advantage of by a third party.
- 3. Structured settlements have a plethora of public policy advantages including ensuring that a settlement is properly invested to take a person's future needs into account and lessening the chance of having to turn to state or federal assistance in the future.
- 4. The Act sets forth certain requirements when a recipient of a structured settlement payment desires to sell their rights to future payments to a third party, including but not limited to the: amounts and due dates of payments to be transferred; aggregate amount of payments, discounted present value; gross amount payable; fees being deducted; net payable; and the quotient of payment to discounted present value. The Court must review all of the above and determine whether the transfer is in the best interests of the payee or his dependents.
- 5. In analyzing the best interests of the payee, courts consider the strength of the need for funds and the immediacy of that need as well as the discount being given to receive funds now along with the possibility of other available and less costly options.
- 6. Wagstaff, LLC filed an Amended Joint Petition for Approval of Transfer of Structured Settlement Payment Rights of \$55,000 due to the payee in 2025 2030. The payee desired the money for home repairs and downpayments on a car and a new home. The payee had over \$200,000 in equity in her current home. In the instant case, the need expressed to complete the home repairs is not a great one and the amount of estimated repairs of \$5,000.00 is not large; the purchase of a new car can be financed and the payee has significant equity in her home and a home equity line of credit or second mortgage would presumably be at lesser rates than are at issue in the proposed transfer. Considering the factors of this case, the Court determined the cash offer cannot be in the best interest of the payee and denied the Petition.

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MEMORANDUM

This matter arises out of the Amended Joint Petition for Approval of Transfer of Structured Settlement Payment Rights filed April 14, 2023 (the "Petition"), filed by Wagstaff, LLC ("Wagstaff" or "Transferee"), and T.K. ("T.K." or "Payee"). Based upon the evidence and testimony presented at a hearing on March 15, 2020, this Court determines that a transfer is not in the best interests of T.K. pursuant to 40 P.S. § 4003(a).

BACKGROUND

T.K. is the beneficiary of an annuity owned by Prudential Assigned Settlement Services Corp with an issuer of The Prudential Insurance Company of America (collectively, "Prudential"). The annuity stems from a personal injury settlement dating from 2016 with future payments remaining of \$321,000.00 in periodic installment through 2058.

T.K. seeks to assign her rights to payments of: (i) \$5,000.00 due on October 18, 2025; (ii) \$20,000.00 due on October 18, 2028; and (iii) \$30,000.00 due on October 18, 2030. The parties did not detail the payment schedule for the remaining \$266,000.00 due pursuant to the structured settlement. The total face value of the amounts requested to be transferred is \$55,000.00. Using a discounted present value rate of 5.0%, the present-day value of the payments is \$40,487.37.

Wagstaff seeks to pay \$27,000.00 in exchange for the assignment of the three payments with present day value of \$40,487.37. Accordingly, the proffered payment is a 33.31% discount on the present-day value. Wagstaff alleges a 12.17% effective annual interest rate.

At the hearing, T.K. stated that she desires the money to pay for home repairs before a sale of her current home in Coatesville (approximately \$5,000.00), downpayment of \$5,000.00-\$10,000.00 for a second car for her family (child and child's parent with whom she resides), and the balance for a downpayment on a new home in Delaware. T.K. further testified that her home is worth approximately \$289,000.00 and that she currently owes approximately \$74,000.00 on the existing mortgage leaving her with substantial equity in excess of \$200,000.00.

DISCUSSION

The Pennsylvania Structured Settlement Protection Act (the "Act"), 40 P.S. §§ 4001-09, exists to ensure an injured individual will not be taken advantage of by a third

² The Amended Joint Petition did not set forth any facts regarding the transfer being in T.K.'s best interest and this court could have denied the petition without hearing on those grounds. In re Jacobs, 936 A.2d 1156 (Pa.Super. 2007) (holding that there is no due process violation in denying a petition on its face pursuant to the Structured Settlement Protection Act, 40 P.S. §§ 4001-09, for failure to comply with Section 4003(a)(3) and allege facts sufficient to support a finding of a transfer being in the petitioner's best interests). 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party. Structured settlements have a plethora of public policy advantages including ensuring that a settlement is properly invested to take a person's future needs into account and lessening the chance of having to turn to state or federal assistance in the future. See In re: Petition of Brie HILTON, 76 Pa. D. & C. 4th 378 (C.P. Mercer Cty 2005) (citing Paul J. Lesti, Structured Settlements § 19:9 and ultimately holding that a transfer was not in the best interests of the payee due to the lack of current needs dire and urgent enough to turn over 54% of the present value of the payment at issue); In re Fee, 2006 WL 3478944 (C.P. Lackawanna Cty 2006) (unreported) (denying a requested fourth and final transfer of all future payments and discussing in great detail the dangers of individuals squandering large lump sum personal injury settlements leading to the adoption of the Act).

The Act sets forth certain requirements when a recipient of a structured settlement payment desires to sell their rights to future payments to a third party including but not limited to the: amounts and due dates of payments to be transferred; aggregate amount of payments, discounted present value; gross amount payable; fees being deducted; net payable; and the quotient of payment to discounted present value. 40 P.S. §4003(2).

The Court must review all of the above and determine that "the transfer is in the best interests of the payee or his dependents." 40 P.S. § 4003(3). *See also* In re Jacobs, 936 A.2d 1156 (Pa.Super. 2007) (discussing the best interest requirement generally). As persuasively noted by the Court of Common Pleas in Philadelphia County:

When placed between the financial interests of an unsophisticated, injured lawsuit plaintiff and a concern that specializes in purchasing, for a discount, plaintiff's annuities, this court does not take lightly its statutory mandate to determine whether the person selling the annuity will reap the full benefit of the bargain—i.e., whether the transfer is truly in his "best interests" based upon the facts.

<u>In re Petition to Transfer Structured Settlement Payment Rights of Curto</u>, 67 Pa. D. & C. 4th 65 (C.P. Phila. Cty 2004) (denying a petition to transfer settlement funds due to, inter alia, the high risk of dissipating all proceeds from the sale).

The Structured Settlement Protection Act defines "best interests" as "[t]he standard applicable to transfers of structured settlement payment rights based on judicial findings regarding the payee and his dependents, as required by section 3(a)(3), unless if at the time the payee and the transferee enter into the transfer agreement a different standard is contained in the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (Public Law 99-514, 26 U.S.C. § 1 *et seq.*) or in a United States Treasury regulation adopted pursuant thereto, then such different standard." 40 P.S. § 4002.

In reviewing decisions by various trial courts in the Commonwealth regarding Section 4003 and analyzing the "best interests" of the petitioner, there appears to be a consensus on two main factors in considering the best interests of a payee pursuant to the Act. One is the need for funds in light of both the strength and immediacy of that need. The second is the discount being given to receive funds now along with the possibility of other available and less costly options. See Hilton, supra; Curto,

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supra; In re Marshall, 2006 WL 1682793 (C.P. Lackawanna Cty 2006) (unreported) (holding that an annuity transfer for 62 cents on the dollar of an entire annuity would be denied but the strong need to reduce monthly living expenses through the purchase of residence justified the discount for a portion of the annuity); In re Macumber, 66 D. & C. 4th 249 (C.P. Monroe Cty 2003) (finding that a discounted present value of fifty-five cents on the dollar was not in the best interests of the petitioner when no valid need existed to justify the discount); In Re Johnny Bush, 152 Pitts.Leg.J. 207 (C.P. Allegheny Cty 2004) (opining that an effective interest rate of 16.32% annually is exorbitant when payment is virtually guaranteed); In re Bendowski, 2006 WL 2988465 (unreported) (stating that a lack of exigency existed for immediate cash and paying 12.73% rendered the proposed assignment not in the best interests of the petitioner).

Presently, this Court finds that the Petition fails on both fronts. The need expressed to complete the home repairs before a prospective sale is not a great one. First, the amount of estimated repairs of \$5,000.00 is not large and no testimony indicated that the current condition of the home renders it unsellable nor that failure to repair would result in a reduction in sales price of equal to or greater than \$5,000.00. Second, the purchase of a new car can be financed at rates below 12% and no testimony was presented that T.K. looked for vehicle financing but could not obtain it for that amount or less. Third, T.K. has significant equity in her home and a home equity line of credit or second mortgage would presumably be at lesser rates. Moreover, any HELOC or second mortgage could be paid off with the \$25,000.00 she is due to receive by October of 2028 avoiding future interest and reducing the total cost of such money. Fourth, the \$200,000.00 plus in equity in T.K.s home can provide a substantial downpayment or full purchase price of the less expensive home that T.K. testified she is seeking in Delaware.

Secondly, the proposed transfers are for a 33.31% discount on the present-day value of the amounts being sold. These are exorbitant discounts on virtually guaranteed money. Even accepting Petitioner's calculation of an imputed 12.17% per year interest on these loans, given: (i) the comparatively low cost of funding available; (ii) still historically average or low mortgage and home equity line rates; (iii) the virtual certainty of payment on the annuities; and (iv) the fact that Petitioner owns a home with equity north of \$200,000.00 in its present condition, the cash offer cannot be in the best interest of Petitioner.

Finally, no evidence was presented why other loan or funding options are not available. In fact, Petitioner testified she has not shopped the payments other than a vague reference to a JG Wentworth potential transfer.³ Accordingly, the Petition is **Denied** as the proposed transfer is not in the best interests of Petitioner pursuant to 40 P.S. § 4003(3).

³ Additionally, no evidence was presented that the transfer would not contravene the terms of the structured settlement or, if so, that "the transfer has been expressly approved in writing by . . . the structured settlement obligor and the annuity issuer[.]" 40 P.S. § 4003(a)(5)(i)(A).
