Crawford vs. Flats, et al.

Discovery - Compel independent medical examination

- 1. The rules governing discovery are intended to prevent surprise and unfairness and to allow a fair trial on the merits.
- 2. It is the general rule that a party may obtain discovery regarding any matter, not privileged, which is relevant to the subject matter involved in the pending action.
- 3. The relevance standard applicable to discovery is broader and more flexible than the relevance standard used at trial for the admission of evidence.
- 4. A party has the right to a court order compelling another party to submit to a physical examination when the physical condition of that party is in controversy and good cause is shown.
- 5. No binding rule or precedent limits a party to one examination; rather, the court shall order an examination when good cause is shown.
- 6. In this premises liability action concerning a fall, Defendants filed a Motion to Compel Plaintiff's Independent Medical Examination by an internalist to explore: (a) whether plaintiff's fall was caused by her aortic stenosis and (b) whether her falls that occurred after the initial fall were caused by her aortic stenosis and not by her injuries from the initial fall. Plaintiffs opposed Defendants' Motion, arguing the examination would be burdensome and irrelevant since her aortic stenosis was mild to moderate at the time of her fall at issue and not severe as it had thereafter become and Defendants should utilize plaintiff's medical records to make determinations of the stages plaintiff was in during relevant falls. Plaintiff also argued Defendants are entitled to only one independent medical examination and plaintiff was already examined by an orthopedic surgeon. This court granted Defendants' Motion to Compel Plaintiff's Independent Medical Examination.

ORDER and MEMORANDUM

AND NOW, this 26th day of August, 2022, upon consideration of Defendants' Motion to Compel Plaintiff's Independent Medical Examination filed May 26, 2022 and Plaintiffs' Response thereto, it is hereby **ORDERED** that the Motion is **GRANTED** and that Plaintiff Kathleen Crawford shall appear for an independent medical examination to be performed by Steven Nierenberg, M.D.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendants shall confer with Plaintiffs and submit to this court an agreed proposed order so the court may comply with Pa.R.Civ.P. 4010(a)(3) which directs the court to enter an order that "specif[ies] the time, place, manner, conditions and scope of the examination and the person or persons by whom it is to be made."

MEMORANDUM

This is a premises liability action where Kathleen Crawford fell from a concrete step on May 26, 2019. Defendants filed their Motion to Compel Plaintiff's Independent Medical Examination on May 26, 2022. Defendants averred that Ms. Crawford's medical records indicate she suffers from severe aortic stenosis which began in 2018 before her fall. Motion, 5/26/2022, ¶¶ 5-7, 14. Defendants asked this court to compel Ms. Crawford to submit to a medical examination by internalist Steven Nierenberg, M.D. to explore: (1) whether Ms. Crawford's fall was caused by her aortic stenosis and (2) whether Ms. Crawford's falls that occurred after the initial fall were caused by her aortic stenosis and not by her injuries from the initial fall. Motion, 5/26/2022, ¶¶ 8, 10, 14.

Plaintiffs opposed Defendants' Motion. Plaintiffs argued that examination of Ms. Crawford in 2022 would be burdensome and irrelevant since her aortic stenosis was mild to moderate on May 26, 2019 and not severe as it is today. Response, 6/6/2022, ¶¶ 5, 7-8, 10, 13-15. Plaintiffs argued that Defendants should "utilize [Ms. Crawford's] medical records to make determinations of the stages [Ms. Crawford] was in during relevant falls to make their argument." Response, 6/6/2022, ¶ 8. See also Response, 6/6/2022, ¶¶ 13, 15. In the alternative Plaintiffs argued that Defendants are entitled to only one independent medical examination and Ms. Crawford has already been examined by an orthopedic surgeon. Response, 6/6/2022, ¶¶ 3-4, 11-12.

This court will grant Defendants' Motion. The rules governing discovery are intended to prevent surprise and unfairness and to allow a fair trial on the merits. Keystone Dedicated Logistics, LLC v. JGB Enterprises, Inc., 77 A.3d 1, 11 (Pa. Super. 2013); McGovern v. Hospital Service Assoc. of Northeastern Pennsylvania, 785 A.2d 1012, 1015 (Pa.Super. 2001); Dominick v. Hanson, 753 A.2d 824, 826 (Pa.Super. 2000). It is the general rule that "a party may obtain discovery regarding any matter, not privileged, which is relevant to the subject matter involved in the pending action." Pa.R.C.P. No. 4003.1(a). See also Berg v. Nationwide Mut. Ins. Co., Inc., 44 A.3d 1164, 1178, fn. 8 (Pa.Super. 2012). The relevance standard applicable to discovery is broader and more flexible than the relevance standard used at trial for the admission of evidence. Com. ex rel. Pappert v. TAP Pharm. Prod., Inc., 904 A.2d 986, 994 (Pa.Cmwlth. 2006); George v. Schirra, 814 A.2d 202, 205-206 (Pa. Super. 2002).

A party has the right to a court order compelling another party to submit to a physical examination when the physical condition of that party is in controversy and good cause is shown. Pa.R.Civ.P. 4010(a). Here, Defendants showed good cause because examination by an internalist may result in an expert opinion that Ms. Crawford's aortic stenosis (however mild at the time) was a cause of her fall on May 26, 2019 and a cause of her falls afterward. This court rejected Plaintiffs' claim of irrelevance as instead an attack on the credibility of any such expert

opinion as may result from examination and this court was not persuaded by Plaintiffs' claim that an examination would be unduly inconvenient or that the availability of Ms. Crawford's medical records vitiates Defendants' rights under Pa.R.Civ.P. 4010(a). Moreover, Plaintiffs have not directed this court to any binding rule or precedent that limits a party to one examination and this court's own research has found none. Indeed, Pa.R.Civ.P. 4010 is silent on the matter and such an unyielding limitation would contradict the rule's directive to the court to order an examination when good cause is shown.

Accordingly, this court will enter an order granting Defendants' Motion to Compel Plaintiff's Independent Medical Examination filed May 26, 2022.




