The hearing will be held in the Franklin County Courthouse, 157 Lincoln Way East, Chambersburg, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, on Thursday, the 23rd day of January 2015 at 1:00 o'clock p.m. If you do not appear at this hearing, the Court may decide that you are not interested in retaining your rights to your child, and your failure to appear may affect the Court's decision on whether to end your rights to your child. You are warned that even if you fail to appear at the scheduled hearing, the hearing will go on without you and the Court may end your rights to your child without you being present. You have a right to be represented at the hearing by a lawyer. You should take this paper to your lawyer at once.
