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Cossaboon vs. Child Guidance Resource Centers, et al.

Set aside defective service - Actual notice - Preliminary objections - Prejudice - Dismissal

1. Generally, original process shall be served within the Commonwealth only by the sheriff.
2. Where service of process is defective, the proper remedy is to set aside the service whereupon the action remains open, but it cannot proceed against a defendant unless the plaintiff can thereafter effect service on such defendant which is sufficient to vest jurisdiction in the court.
3. When a plaintiff fails to perfect service but has supplied the defendant with actual notice of the litigation, the court should only dismiss the complaint where plaintiffs' failure to comply with the Rules of Civil Procedure has prejudiced defendant.
4. Plaintiff's failure to perfect service of original process, alone, does not warrant dismissing Plaintiff's complaint.
5. Plaintiff alleged her application to be a licensed professional counselor was rejected because Defendants failed to verify she completed the required number of supervised clinical hours. Plaintiff sought an injunction to compel Defendants to provide the required verification and sought nearly \$400,000 in damages. Defendants filed numerous preliminary objections, the first alleged improper service of process because neither server was employed by the Sheriff's office. Defendants' preliminary objections are overruled without prejudice to Defendants' right to file a motion to set aside service or seek other relief as appropriate. This Court cannot reach the merits of the remainder of Defendants' preliminary objections because this action remains open but cannot proceed.

MEMORANDUM

This is a case where Plaintiff alleged she submitted an application to be a Licensed Professional Counselor to the State Board of Social Workers, Marriage and Family Therapists and Professional Counselors which rejected her application because Defendants failed to verify that she completed the required number of supervised clinical hours. Plaintiff seeks an injunction compelling Defendants to provide the required verification and \$388,845.00 in damages.

Defendants filed numerous Preliminary Objections on May 19, 2022. Defendants styled the first as “Preliminary Objection Pursuant to 1028(a) (1): Improper Service of Process.” Preliminary Objections, 5/18/2022, p. 3. Defendants averred they have the right to be served original process by the Sheriff pursuant to Pa.R.C.P. No. 400(a) and that “[t]he Affidavits of Service which Plaintiff filed with this Court demonstrate that Defendants Child Guidance Resource Center, Laura Miller and Jenette Fremuth were served by two individuals named “King” and “M. Cossaboon.” Preliminary Objections, 5/18/2022, ¶ 12. *See also* Preliminary Objections, 5/18/2022, Exhibit “B.” Defendants averred that neither King nor M. Cossaboon are the Sheriff so “Plaintiff’s Complaint should be stricken.” Preliminary Objections, 5/18/2022, ¶¶ 13-14.

Here, this court agrees with Defendants that this case is within the general rule by which “original process shall be served within the Commonwealth only by the sheriff.” Pa.R.C.P. No. 400(a). As of the date of this order, the docket reflects six filings which purport to be a certificate or affidavit of service of original process none of which are a sheriff’s return of service pursuant to Pa.R.C.P. No. 405. However, this court cannot grant Defendants the relief they have requested. “Where service of process is defective, the proper remedy is to set aside the service [whereupon] the action remains open, but it cannot proceed against a defendant unless the plaintiff can thereafter effect service on such defendant which is sufficient to vest jurisdiction in the court.” *Weaver v. Martin*, 655 A.2d 180, 184 (Pa.Super. 1995) (quoting *Collins v. Park*, 621 A.2d 996, 999 (Pa.Super. 1993), *allocatur denied*, 637 A.2d 278 (Pa. 1993), citing *Frycklund v. Way*, 599 A.2d 1332 (Pa. 1991)). *See also* *Harris v. Couttieu*, 261 A.3d 527, 529-30 (Pa.Super. 2021) (“when a plaintiff fails to perfect service but has supplied the defendant with actual notice of the litigation, the court should only dismiss the complaint ‘where plaintiffs’ failure to comply with the Rules of Civil Procedure has prejudiced defendant.’”) (quoting *McCreech v. City of Philadelphia*, 888 A.2d 664, 674 (Pa. 2005)) (footnote and emphasis omitted). Defendants make no claim of prejudice and Plaintiff’s failure to perfect service of original process, alone, does not warrant dismissing Plaintiff’s Complaint. It is clear that Defendants are not voluntarily submitting to this court’s exercise of personal jurisdiction and that the remainder of Defendants’ Preliminary Objections are raised in the alternative. This court cannot reach the merits of the remainder of Defendants’ Preliminary Objections because this action remains open but cannot proceed.

Accordingly, this court will enter an order overruling Defendants' Preliminary Objections without prejudice to Defendants' right to file a motion to set aside service or seek other relief as appropriate.

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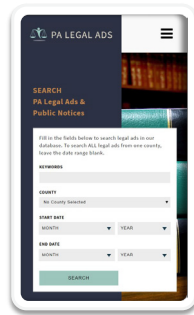
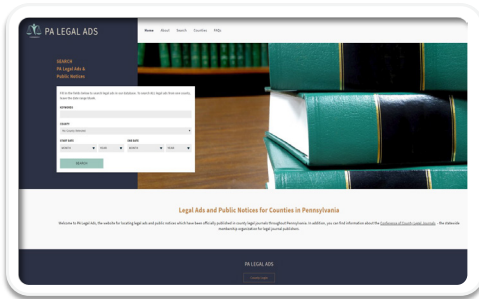
