

AND NOW, This 9th day of February, 2012, pursuant to Pennsylvania Rules of Juvenile Court Procedure 195 and 23 Pa.C.S. § 6315, Juvenile Probation Officers of York County are hereby granted the following authority:

If, in the course of their regular duties, York County Juvenile Probation Officers encounter situations in which they believe a child who is not under Juvenile Probation supervision should be taken into Protective Custody, the Juvenile Probation Officer should contact County Control and remain at the scene until police arrive. If there is concern that the child might abscond or that other

persons may attempt to interfere, the Probation Officer shall have authority to temporarily take the child into custody and transport him or her to a safer location to await the arrival of police. If the child appears to be seriously injured or in need of immediate medical attention, the Probation Officer should request that County Control also dispatch an ambulance.

District Court Administrator shall:

(a). Provide one certified copy of this Administrative Order to the Clerk of Courts of York County to be kept continuously available for public inspection and for copying. Upon request and payment of reasonable fees for reproduction and mailing, Clerk of Court shall furnish a copy to any person requesting a copy.
